Enterprise Architecture(TOGAF 9 Foundation)

Course Introduction

Organizations need to transform their strategic plans into action through a concise implementation process. Often managers and staff struggle to communicate the same message. This is one of the main hurdles in achieving the set performance goals. Enterprise Architecture (EA) is the bridge between business and technology; it is about aligning business and technology.
